

## The Brief: London Fire Brigade – Maintaining 50 drainage systems

Moolands maintain the drainage systems in 50 London Fire Stations across London.

We maintain the following areas:

- Rainwater drainage
- Rainwater downpipes and Gutters
- Separator systems for light oils – petrol interceptors
- Sewage or drainage pumps
- Sanitary waste water
- Manhole covers
- Deep Lift pits



With so many stations to manage and the need for 24-hour call-out, careful and thoughtful planning is crucial for this work. We understand the importance of conducting our operations sensitively, especially with the constant movement of vehicles around us. To ensure everyone's wellbeing, we set up safety barriers and clear signage in the work areas. Our goal is to keep things running smoothly while looking out for both our team and the public.



Our office staff contact each of the stations in advance to arrange a convenient time to schedule the works. Upon completion, the engineers send a comprehensive report to the office where this information is collated and forwarded onto London Fire Brigade Head Office.
